

PERMITS INFORMATION

Permit Transfer Application

July 2010

- This application must be lodged with the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority (GBRMPA) a minimum of 20 business days prior to the proposed date of transfer.
- This application must be completed in full, and signed by the current permit holder and the intended permit holder or, where one or both of the parties is a company, **must** be signed by a Director of the company (See Section D overpage).
- Where the permit being transferred includes a Mooring, then the information specified in Section C overpage **must** be provided.

SECTION C

Mooring information to be supplied

- A. A copy of the current '*approved drawing*'* for the relevant mooring and must illustrate as a minimum:
- type of mooring system – single point mooring or fore-and-aft mooring;
 - intended use – ancillary mooring or primary mooring;
 - mooring components – type of anchor (screw/block/pin), anchor dimensions (weight and dimensions), mooring riser line details (specifications of anchor chain, mooring line, subsurface buoy, shackles), surface buoy details (dimensions and volume);
 - vessel capacity (length and weight);
 - design conditions (wind speed, maximum wave height, water depth, current).
- B. A copy of the latest mooring maintenance certificate (no more than 12 months old).
- C. Details of the mooring location – DGPS preferably (but can be GPS).
- D. Proof that the mooring reference numbers are attached to the mooring buoy (eg photo or statutory declaration).

* '*Approved drawing*' means a technical drawing of a mooring system, approved by a marine engineer or naval architect.

SECTION D

To be signed by both parties

Where the current permit holder and/or intended permit holder is a company, this declaration must be signed in the name of the company by a Director.
