GBRMPA copyright and licensing

This application form should be used to apply for permission to copy, reproduce or modify GBRMPA spatial data or for permission to copy GBRMPA spatial data which has been used in other people's products. General

Your application will tell GBRMPA who you are and what you want to use our spatial data for. GBRMPA can then see whether we have suitable spatial data for you and whether you are likely to qualify for one of our licences. We can also see whether your proposal is for a commercial or non-commercial use. This will affect what GBRMPA will charge you.

GBRMPA might need to ask for more information at any time while we are processing your application.

We have left space on this form for your answers. If any of your answers will not fit into the space, please continue them on a separate sheet. If it is more convenient, you can present all your answers on your own paper. If you do this, please use A4 format pages and cross reference your answers to the numbered questions on this form. Also include this front page as the cover to your submission.

Remember the more relevant information you can provide, the easier it will be for us to decide if you can have a licence. Extracts from such things as your business plan, a research grant application or a prospectus would all be useful additional information for your application.
